



Elder-Pet Disposition Form

Here at Sidekick Sitter, Inc (DBA Oak Brook Kennel Club or OBKC) our top priority is the comfort and safety of your pet family member. Special care must be given to elderly pets. Signs of aging in pets varies by breed, size and species. As a general rule, any pet that is older than 10 years is considered a 'senior pet' at OBKC. As such, we will take extra precaution with their exercise, feeding and medication. In the unlikely event of their passing while at our facility, we want you to understand our disposition procedures.

In the rare and unfortunate event that your pet succumbs during a stay with us:

We will contact you or your emergency contact immediately.

- We cannot hold your pet's remains at our facility for any reason.
- We will transport your pet's remains directly to VCA Arboretum View Animal Hospital, 2551 Warrenville Road, Downers Grove, IL. Arboretum View is a 24x7/365 emergency veterinarian hospital equipped to temporarily store remains.
- We will not release your pet's remains directly to you, a family member, neighbor, emergency contact or any other individual.
- Arrangements for pick up, transfer, release or cremation of your pet's remains is a private matter and must be made directly through Arboretum View.
- Any fees applied by Arboretum View associated with the transfer, holding, necropsy, cremation or burial of your pet will be borne by the Owner.
- We will release your pet's remains at your discretion to a licensed Pet Cemetery provided prior arrangements have been made and we have a copy of the signed agreement.
- OBKC will transport your pet's remains to Arboretum View at no cost.

Our Staff are trained to perform cardiopulmonary resuscitation (CPR) for canines and felines. In the event that your pet requires CPR, we will make every attempt to resuscitate your pet. If you do not wish us to perform CPR on your pet, please indicate DO NOT RESUSCITATE below.

NOTE: An order not to resuscitate will not preclude OBKC from treating or seeking veterinary treatment of routine injury or illness in my pet.
